We do not want to lose that. When we start acting like assholes, we lose that. Let's keep our eyes on the prize, and hit the federal government where it hurts. We want the mandates gone. Mandates need to be removed and we're not leaving until they are. Thanks, guys.

Um, this is – this is definitely a tense situation and we, uh – we don't need anything to go bad to ruin our cause, so if anybody's having any issues or everybody's thinking about doing something stupid, you get a hold of me and I will come and see you. I will hug you; I will do whatever it takes to make you happy. Send you home if you have to. Like, I – I don't care. We need this peaceful. Uh, law enforcement's been really good but they're – they're trying to close your fuel off. They're trying to close your food off. And, um, they're trying to get us cleaned out of here. Ottawa doesn't want us here. The city's already mentioned that. We got a snowstorm coming in tomorrow, so just be patient, be strong, hold the line. All the provinces are already starting to lift mandates. Um, so we're winning at this, right? We're winning at this, guys. Hang in there.

Um, yeah, just run myself into the ground. Run myself right into the ground. I haven't had enough sleep. It's just a little bit of pressure sometimes, you know? Just a little bit, I guess. Tamara's stressed right to the nuts, too, so – um, we got this, guys. So, I'll keep talking to you. Keep talking to me. Tell me what your concerns are. Get a hold of me. The phone rings 90 percent of the time, so what's a little bit more? See you guys.

- KEITH WILSON: We're about peaceful protest. This emergency order from the federal government does not restrict Canadian's rights of peaceful assembly; however, what we can see on the ground here is the police look to be gearing up. It looks like the federal government is going to tell the police to go and use violence against lawful protestors, and one way to stop that from happening is Canadians who are concerned about their rights and government overreach to come to Ottawa as soon as you can get here and stand with the truckers. We believe the police are reluctant to follow this. If they follow what the federal government's telling the police to do, it will be an illegal order. It will be unlawful. So, if you come and stand with the protestors, it will make it harder for the police to act on what they're being told to do and it's really important that freedom-loving Canadians get to Ottawa as soon as possible to stand with the truckers and exercise their legal Charter rights of peaceful assembly.

One. End all vaccine mandates for all Canadians, truckers, travellers, employees, healthcare workers, law enforcement agents, and soldiers. Number two. Cancel provincial and municipal vaccine passports and masking requirements. Number three. End all state of emergency declarations. Number four. Allow those who have lost their jobs to go back to work. Number five. Grant access to parents that lost access to their kids, be reunited. Six. Financial protection for all small businesses harmed by COVID restrictions. And seven, respect freedom of choice and not discriminate. We call upon our governments to ensure we don't make this same mistake again by doing the following. Number one. Supreme Court of Canada review of government actions. We need to know whether our rights under their, under the charter mean anything. We call upon the federal government to initiate a constitutional reference question to the Supreme Court of Canada about the constitutional validity of COVID laws and restrictions. Two. Public enquiry of government's response to COVID. As a matter of national importance, we call upon the federal government to appoint a fully independent and impartial public enquiry on the government's handling of COVID responses. We need to know what went wrong, what caused governments to so easily trample our rights and freedoms and cause so much harm to our people and nation. For the enquiry to be effective, the following conditions must be considered. A) the enquiry members to be selected by an all-party process, B) it must contain a thorough examination of the science, policy responses, and the consequences, C) it must be commenced by March 20th, 2022 and D) it must be public and livestreamed.
