Dear Ms. Pejovic:

On behalf of the South East Cornerstone Public School Division (the "Division"), I write in response to your correspondence dated June 22, 2026, and August 28, 2026.

In regards to the questions raised in your correspondence, students' access to washrooms throughout the Division is managed on a case-by-case basis and in accordance with applicable legislation, which includes both human rights legislation and privacy obligations, and with careful consideration of student safety, dignity, and well-being.

As we previously advised in our letter dated June 15, 2026, each school in the Division provides male, female, and gender-neutral washroom facilities for student use. Single-stall, gender-neutral washrooms are available to any student who chooses to use them, regardless of gender or reason for use, and provide an additional private option for all students.

Student safety is a priority in all school spaces. Specific safety or conduct concerns that are brought to the attention of school administration are reviewed and addressed through appropriate school processes. The Division continues to address specific operational or safety concerns as they arise, consistent with its legal obligations and its responsibility to provide a safe, respectful, and inclusive school environment.
